

The Borough of Cheltenham (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2020

(Variation No. 4) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Cheltenham (“the Council”) **intends to** make an Order under Sections 32 and 35 of and under Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers with the consent of Gloucestershire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order will relate to parking places (“parking place”) at Bath Terrace, Church Piece, St James Street and Whitefriars at Sixways.

The effect of the Order will be to remove part of each parking place above from The Borough of Cheltenham (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2020 (“the 2020 Order”) to enable these areas to be leased for the installation of electric vehicle charging stations.

The Order will also make amendments to Schedule 2 of the 2020 Order (Season Tickets, Permits and Eligibility) in relation to staff and member car parking in addition to removing references to Cheltenham Borough Homes staff parking Malvern Walk and Royal Well.
